A key part of Australian immigration, over 250,000 Australians can trace their heritage back to the City of Adelaide and so today we honour the craftsmanship of William Pile.

Varietal: Shiraz

Vintage: 2021

Region: Coonawarra, South Australia

Viticulture: Sourced from a low yielding single vineyard in the heart of Coonawarra on the famous terra rossa soil over limestone. This valuable patch of land is the holy grail of all Shiraz purists; with soil vivid red in colour, it is perfect for growing exceptional full-bodied red wines.

Winemaking: Hand picked, lightly crushed, 15 days fermentation. Matured for 24 months in 30% new French and American hogsheads and barriques, balance in 1 year and older.

Tasting Notes: This Shiraz is full bodied with a smooth rich texture. The notes of dark berries, bay leaf and dark chocolate are nicely balanced with spicy oak characters. The lengthy palate is concentrated and mouth filling.

Alcohol: 14.5% alc/vol
